CAMPUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Instruction is provided on campus five days a week • 3-4 core academic classes a day • Specials classes (music, dance, PE, or art) every day • 2-3 Spanish classes a week • Breaks for lunch and at least two recesses a day
REMOTE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Instruction is provided five days a week in alignment with the campus schedule (see above) • Students attend core classes and specials synchronously • Connection and differentiated instruction provided through small group and 1:1 student-teacher sessions. • Depending on the number of students in each grade who opt into remote learning, variations may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ synchronous participation in campus instruction ◦ a distinct remote program that parallels campus instruction and employs both synchronous and asynchronous instruction • Regular off-screen breaks for outdoor activity, play, and nourishment
