

Learning Modes	Middle Division
<b>CAMPUS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Instruction is provided on campus five days a week, using the rotating 8-day schedule in alignment with the Upper Division.</li> <li>• 4-5 core academic classes a day (Spanish, Math, English, History, STEM)</li> <li>• Specials classes (music, dance, PE, and art)</li> <li>• Breaks for lunch, advisory meetings, and recess</li> </ul>
<b>REMOTE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Instruction is provided five days a week in alignment with the campus schedule (see above)</li> <li>• Students attend core classes and specials synchronously and asynchronously</li> <li>• Depending on the number of students in each grade who opt into remote learning, variations may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ synchronous participation in campus instruction</li> <li>◦ a distinct remote program that parallels campus instruction and employs both synchronous and asynchronous instruction</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
