Dormitory Packing & Supplies Checklist

Laundry

Each dormitory has washers and dryers. It is helpful to new students if they are familiar with the operation of washers, dryers, and doing laundry before they arrive at school.

- □ 1-2 laundry bags
- □ Laundry detergent
- Fabric softener or dryer sheets (if desired)

Bedding and Bath

Students will need to provide and launder their own linens. Beds are regular twin size mattresses.

- □ Sheets (1 or 2 twin-sized sheet sets)
- Pillows and 2 pillowcases
- Comforter/duvet and duvet cover
- □ 1-2 towels and toilettries

Clothing

Along with regular school clothing, we require all resident students to bring nice clothing for formal dinners on Monday evenings and other dress-up events. Each student may choose from the following types of clothing:

formal dresses	sport coat, tie
skirts	dress shirt
nice slacks	nice slacks
blouses	belt
dress shoes	dress shoes, non-athletic socks

PLEASE NOTE: Hems must be at least finger-tip length and shoulders must be covered (sleeveless dresses will need a cardigan or wrap, etc.). No denim is permitted at Monday night dinners. Culturally appropriate formal wear (e.g. a kimono) is also permissible with the approval of the Dorm Head.
