World Languages Placement Requirements Returning Students 2022

Students coming from a Stevenson Chinese course will be placed in a One Schoolhouse course through a consultation with their teacher that takes into account their background and their interests.

Students coming from a Stevenson Level 1 language course:

- Earning an A- or better in the spring semester or the recommendation of their Level 1 teacher may take Level 2 Honors
- Earning a C- or better may take Level 2
- Earning less than a C- should repeat Level 1 or study the language during the summer, and take a placement test for Level 2.

Students coming from a Stevenson Level 2 language course:

- Earning a C- or better in the spring semester may take Level 3
- Earning less than a C- should repeat Level 2.
- Students from a Stevenson Level 2 regular class who wish to take 3 Honors the following year must earn an A in the spring semester, get the approval of the department head in conference with the Level 2 teacher, and complete agreed-upon summer work.

Students coming from a Stevenson Level 2 Honors language course:

- Earning an A- or better in conjunction with the recommendation of their Level 2 Honors teacher may take Level 3 Honors.
- Earning a B+ or below will be placed by their teacher.

Students coming from a Stevenson Level 3 language course:

- Earning a C- or better in the spring semester may take Level 4
- Earning less than a C- should repeat Level 3.
- Students from a Stevenson Level 3 regular class who wish to take AP the following year must earn an A in the spring semester, get the approval of the department head in conference with the Level 3 teacher, and complete agreed-upon summer work.

Students coming from a Stevenson Level 3 Honors language course:

- Earning an A- or better in conjunction with the recommendation of their Level 3 Honors teacher may take AP.
- Earning a B+ or below will be placed by their teacher.

Students coming from a Stevenson Level 4 language course:

- Earning a C- or better in the spring semester may take Level 5 (if offered)
- Earning less than a C- should repeat Level 4.
- Students from a Stevenson Level 4 regular class who wish to take AP the following year must earn an A in the spring semester, get the approval of the department head in conference with the Level 4 teacher, and complete agreed-upon summer work.

Students coming from a Stevenson AP language course:

- Earning an A- in the spring semester may take Level 5 (if offered)
